

## SELECTION POLICY

### Individual Trampoline, Synchronised Trampoline and Double Mini Trampoline

Performers are invited to submit scores to be selected to be members of the 2010 England Trampoline and Double Mini Trampoline Squad. From these squads, two teams will be selected to represent England at the 2010 Loule Cup, Loule, POR and Home Nations Championships, Gloucester, GBR.

**Selection Categories:** Squad Competition. (Self Funded)  
A squad of no more than 24 Individual trampolinists comprising of up to 6 members in each of the following categories;

- Under 17 Boys (Born 2001 – 1994)
- Under 17 Girls (Born 2001 – 1994)
- 17+ Men (Born 1993 or earlier)
- 17+ Ladies (Born 1993 or earlier)

A squad of no more 24 double mini trampolinists comprising of up to 6 members in each of the following categories;

- Under 17 Boys (Born 2001 – 1994)
- Under 17 Girls (Born 2001 – 1994)
- 17+ Men (Born 1993 or earlier)
- 17+ Ladies (Born 1993 or earlier)

Synchronised pairs will be selected from within the squad with no places allocated to stand alone synchronised pairs.

**Eligibility:** The English team will be comprised of those who are of English Nationality and eligible to hold a full British passport.

Senior competitors who have represented Great Britain, or have been selected to do so in 2010 in a senior category at an Olympic Games, World Games, World Championships or European Championships are **ineligible** to apply.

Please note performers who are currently on a world class programme (Development or Podium as of 1<sup>st</sup> September 2009) will not be eligible for selection in either the individual or synchronised trampoline teams.

Must be in possession of a current FIG license.

**Squad Selection Criteria:** *Individual Trampoline*

- In order to be considered for selection, the performer must have achieved a minimum score outlined in the scoring matrix below at any listed qualification event.
- To be considered for selection, you must submit the performer's **two** best preliminary round scores (the set score and first voluntary score). An average of the submitted scores will be taken to produce a ranking.
- The top six ranked performers in each age category outlined in "Selection Categories" above will be selected to the 2010 England squads.

*Double Mini Trampoline*

- In order to be considered for selection, the performer must have achieved the minimum scores outlined in the scoring matrix below at any listed qualification event.
- To be considered for selection, you must submit the performer's **two** best total round scores (total of the preliminary round and final round score from the same event). An average of the submitted scores will be taken to produce a ranking.
- The top six ranked performers in each age category outlined in "Selection Categories" above will be selected to the 2010 England squads.

- Eligible competitions:** Scores may be submitted from any 2009 FIG A/FIG B domestic gala or the 2009 National Finals, plus any 2010 Youth FIG registered international or FIG A/FIG B domestic galas in 2010, providing the performer has not moved from the U17 to the 17+ age category.
- Submission:** To be considered for selection, please submit the performer's best **TWO** sets of scores from the listed qualification competitions along with the performer's date of birth to [paultramp@yahoo.co.uk](mailto:paultramp@yahoo.co.uk) on or before **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> May 2010**.
- Squad Conditions:** Prior to submitting scores, each performer **must** be able to commit to attending three training sessions/trial events and to be able to compete at two events, namely the Loule Cup, POR (Late September 2010 – TBC) and the Home Nations, GBR (24<sup>th</sup> October 2010).
- Each performer in the squad will be issued with full England kit.
- The cost of the kit, training camps and competitions must be met in their entirety by the performer. Funding has been applied for but there is currently no confirmation that it will be available, therefore the performer must be prepared to meet the costs of all the squad activities in their entirety.
- Finances:** All prices are approximate and subject to change;

**Squad Training Camps:** The England squad will be expected to meet a total of three times (see dates below);

Birmingham – 29<sup>th</sup> May

London – 31<sup>st</sup> July

Liverpool – 4<sup>th</sup> September

Birmingham will be to meet and greet the coaches and performers, the first training session and distribution of squad kit.

London will be a training session followed by an in-house trial event where 4 members from each age category within the squad will be selected to represent England at the Loule Cup, POR.

Liverpool will be the last training session of 2010 followed by an in-house event where 4 members from each age category within the squad will be selected to represent England at the Home Nations, GBR.

**Notification:**

Notification of selection of the England squad will be made by Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2010. The team will be posted on the [www.englishgymnastics.org.uk](http://www.englishgymnastics.org.uk) website and the [www.bg-coaches.org](http://www.bg-coaches.org) website.

**Removal:**

A Gymnast may be removed from the 2010 English squad/team at any stage prior to the competition, due to any reason which might inhibit the performance of the team (i.e. illness or injury). Verification of injury or illness will be by two medical personnel approved by British Gymnastics.

A Gymnast may be removed from the 2010 English squad/team in the event of non-compliance in training, a breach of responsibility to the team or a violation of the codes of behaviour.



A Gymnast may only be removed from the 2010 English team/squad by the England Head Coach after consultation with the England Team Coaches and/or medical personnel approved by English Gymnastics.

Prior to removal the performer being removed must be presented with the opportunity to attend a removal interview with the EGA Liaison and/or England Coaches and one other independent person.

Written justification must be provided for all removals. Any decision to remove an athlete or coach is subject to review through English Gymnastics Appeals Procedure.
